His current research interests are in the molecular pathogenesis of Hodgkin lymphoma, Anaplastic Large Cell Lymphoma, chronic lymphoproliferative disorders, and acute monoblastic leukemia. He is also the director of the Canadian Institutes for Health Research (CIHR) Clinician Scientists' Training Program in Molecular Pathology for the BCCA site of the program.
