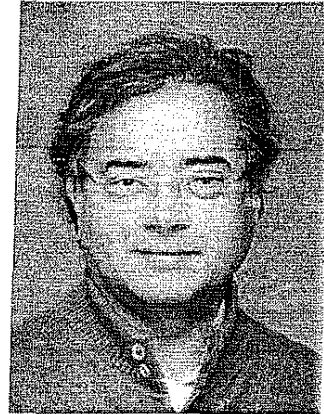

Biographical summary

Dr. Diponkar Banerjee was appointed the Provincial Program Leader, Cancer Pathology for the British Columbia Cancer Agency (BCCA), and Director of Laboratories at the Vancouver Cancer Centre in 2000. He is a Clinical Professor of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at the University of British Columbia. He was previously Chief of Oncologic Pathology at the Princess Margaret Hospital/Ontario Cancer Institute from 1991-2000. He is the discipline leader for Anatomic Pathology within Provincial Health Services Authority's Laboratories. His current research interests are in the molecular pathogenesis of Hodgkin lymphoma, Anaplastic Large Cell Lymphoma, chronic lymphoproliferative disorders, and acute monoblastic leukemia. He is also the director of the Canadian Institutes for Health Research (CIHR) Clinician Scientists' Training Program in Molecular Pathology for the BCCA site of the program.
