Hi- I am currently the Access to Information and Protection of Privacy (ATIPP) coordinator for Eastern Health. We had a request from a reporter, asking for the actual ER/PR test results of the patients affected, with the local results and the re-test results from Mt. Sinai (anonymised of course). We denied the release, citing that the results were personal information of our patients. The reporter has appealed to the Privacy Commissioner who has ordered the reports sent to his office for review (we've been down this road before- we are legally obligated to send the reports to the Privacy Commissioner's office). We have to provide the reports by next week. I discussed this with Heather and we need your advice about how these reports can be generated as expeditiously as possible.
