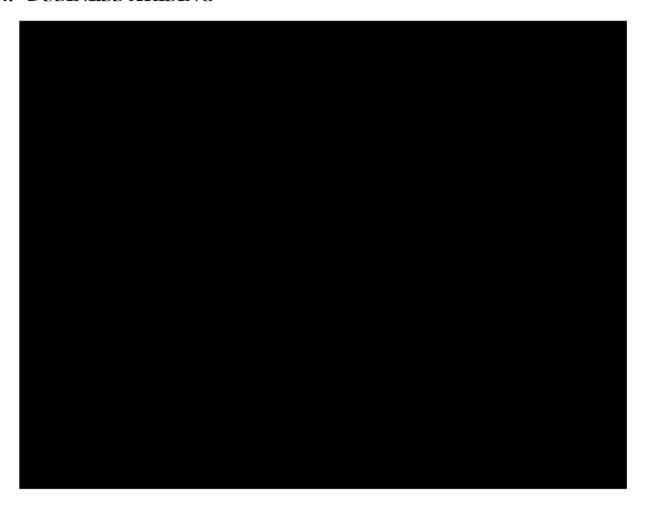

8.1 Organization Structure

Since the last meeting the following positions are in place; Regional Director of Maintenance, Human Resources Managers and Information Systems Managers. The Executive is in the process of interviewing for the Finance positions. The following positions have been posted; Directors of Health Services and Directors of Community Services. The following two positions in the Grand Falls-Windsor region has been declared redundant; the former Director of Laboratory Services and the Nurse Manager at the Carmelite House.

8.2 Cancer Clinic Update

The renovations for the Gander Cancer Clinic are on target. The tender for the Grand Falls-Windsor Cancer Clinic had been delayed due to concerns from the Fire Commissioner. However government has given the approval to move forward with the tender.





8.7 ER/PR Breast Cancer Testing

An article from the Globe and Mail was circulated on ER/PR Breast Cancer Testing. ER/PR testing for the province is conducted by the lab in Eastern Health. A problem with the procedure was identified over the summer and these problems go back as far as 1999. This resulted in some patients from Central Newfoundland testing negative where they should have tested positive. Eastern Health is coordinating retesting and contact with patients from the four regions.

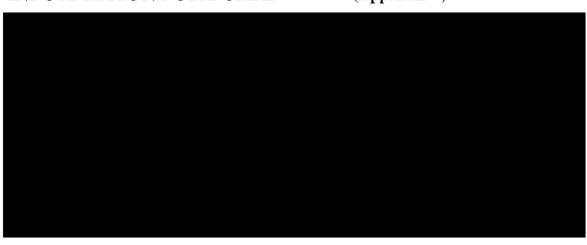
