Public Hearings for the Commission of Inquiry on Hormone Receptor Testing Set to Begin

This includes interviewing or re-interviewing potential witnesses who, prior to the decision of the Supreme Court of Newfoundland and Labrador on February 14th, 2008, were not in a position to discuss the content of certain reports.
