5. **Budget**


2004/05 ended with a deficit of \$180,000. This was an improvement over 2003/04 which was \$650,000.

The 2005/06 budget has been approved and Terry feels that the Lab should be able to balance this year.


6. **Lab Planning Day (major objectives)**


