This expertise has led to increasing recognition of the Department particularly in neuropathology, gynecologic pathology and nephropathology, gastroenterology, endocrine pathology, ENT pathology

A popular choice with residents, the JGH Department of Pathology is a core program at McGill University, and carries a heavy load of teaching at the postgraduate levels as well as interdepartmental conferences.

Members of the Department of Pathology conduct basic and applied research projects involve collaboration with other hospital departments. Areas of interest include molecular biology of tumors (cancer genes), cancer of the cervix, head and neck cancer and breast cancer. In addition, Dr. Lesley Alton, who is the head of the department, which collects and provides tissues for the McGill University Centre for Cancer Research.

Furthermore the Department has a division of Cytology which is responsible for the screening of Pap smears. They receive a high volume of gynaecological and non-gynaecological screening. The chief Cytotechnologist is Mrs Juliette Robitaille.
