Hi folks

I just had a call from Dr. Bob Williams. The ER/PR test results from Mount Sinai are back, and I should be getting a call from Heather Pridham today with the results for western region patients. We will be required to notify the patients with negative results. For those with positive results who are patients of the cancer clinic in St John's, an expert panel in St. John's will review the results and provide advice to treating providers. For those with positive results who are not cancer clinic patients, it is anticipated that further clinical information will need to be provided so that the cases can be reviewed by the expert panel and advice provided.

We will need to have some staffing supports to call the patients who are negative, and advise attending physicians of the positive converters for whom further info is required. For Kelli, can Bonnie Walker be made available to do this or should I look elsewhere?
