Subject: Panel update

Hi,

I just wanted to give you the stats from the panel yesterday evening.

We reviewed 23 patients (2 that we picked didn't require panelling as they didn't convert. QSI will contact them and let them know)

- 9 required no action
- 13 will be recommended for Tamoxifen
- 1 had died and will be added to that list to be dealt with at a later date

So, with the numbers from the previous two weeks, that gives us, out of a total of 46, 21 whose treatment has been impacted.

One of those patients recommended for tamoxifen, is a patient Mount Sinai tested twice and came back with different results. We spent alot of time discussing this and the method of disclosure as we have one other patient in this situation, and may have more. When Kara returns, she and I will meet with the lady and/or her family (it's a complicated situation) and tell them. we can discuss this in more detail if you would like.

It seems that Dr. Cook has more results back than I was aware of, so I'm taking some time this morning to review all the names and stats comparing them to Dr. Cook's and hopefully Terry's latest list.
