Hi all,

I just wanted to give you an update on the calls we (Nancy mostly) has received today re: ER/PR

1. A lady called concerned about the lack of information she received from her physicians when she was having diagnostic tests done. She was a bit upset previously but the media attention got her more upset. This has nothing to do with ER/PR
2. A lady called asking whether she was retested. She is originally from Carbonear and is not on any of our lists so we are checking with the lab there to see if she was ER negative. From the information she told Nancy, Nancy feels that she's a bit confused about the issue and that her biopsy was negative and she never had cancer.
3. Husband of a lady who died called. He had called last year and knew that his wife was retested and was a confirmed negative. He was just calling to make sure.
4. A lady called saying that she had been called and told she was going to be retested, but she had heard nothing else. She was confirmed negative and she was noted to have been contacted. (This highlights the fact that all this was done verbally and maybe we should have written follow-up letters to all the confirmed negative???)
5. Another lady who converted called for information about the class action lawsuit. She was recommended for Tamoxifen but she was ER<10/pr<10 in 2000 and came back from Mount Sinai as ER 10 and PR 20....so she is one of the ones that didn't change fundamentally, but the definition of negative changed.
6. Another lady called saying she was ER/PR negative in 1997 and never knew anything about all this. When I spoke with her and checked her pathology she was ER positive 50-60%. I told her this and she's OK with this.
7. Another lady who was retested and is a confirmed negative called and wanted a copy of her pathology report. Nancy is arranging for her to get that.
